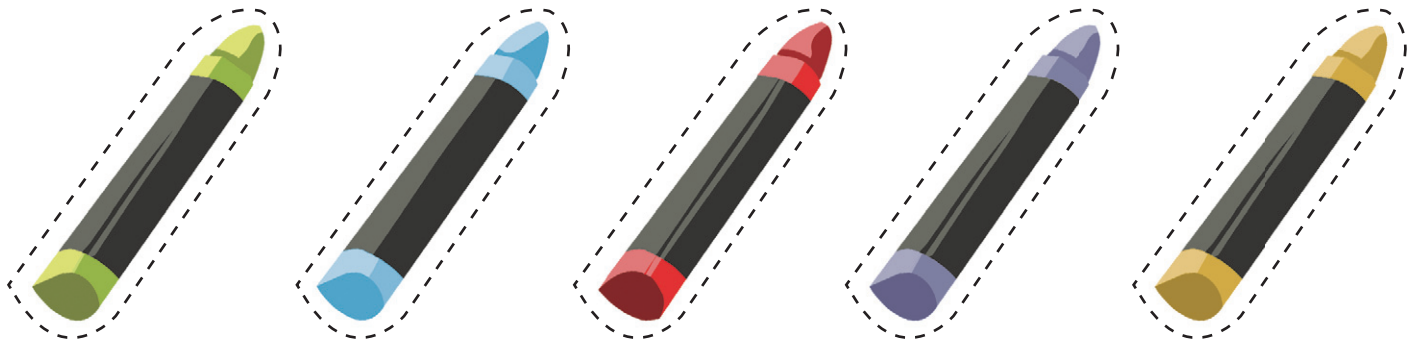

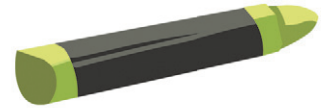

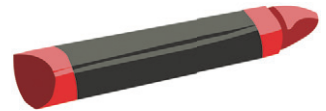

Audio Script

NARRATOR: Look at the pictures. Listen and look. There is one example.

WOMAN: What is Peter's favorite color? Is it blue?

MAN: Yes, it is. It's blue.

NARRATOR: Can you see the line from Peter to the blue crayon? This is an example. Now you listen and draw lines between the columns.

NARRATOR: One.

WOMAN: What is Baggins' favorite color? Is it yellow?

MAN: No, it isn't. It's green.

Speaking Procedure

Preparation: Cut out the crayons individually.

1. Greet the student. Invite him/her to sit down. Have a brief conversation as a warm-up.

Example dialogue

T: Hello. My name's _____. What's your name?

S: (My name's) _____.

T: How old are you?

S: (I'm) _____ (years old).

2. Display the crayons in front of the student. Ask him/her to point to each by saying, "Show me the (red) crayon."

3. Call the student's attention to the large picture. Ask two or three of the following questions. Expect the student to point or to answer with one or two words:

Where is Lucy?

What is Ra doing?

Where is Peter?

What is Baggins doing?

Where is Baggins?

Are they eating?

Where is Ra?

Are they in the kitchen?

Where is Nessie?

Who is happy?

4. Take one of the crayons and say its color. Then say where you're putting it while doing it. Then tell the student to take a crayon and put it in a place in the picture, following your instructions. Do this for two other crayons.

Example dialogue

T [TAKING THE RED CRAYON]: I'm taking the red crayon. [PUTTING IT ON THE TABLE] I'm putting the crayon on the table. Okay? Now you do it. Take the blue crayon.

S [TAKES THE BLUE CRAYON]

T: Put the blue crayon next to Nessie.

S [PUTS PICTURE OF BLUE CRAYON NEXT TO NESSIE]

T: Good! Now tell me, where is the blue crayon?

S: It's next to Nessie. / Here.

Speaking Score Guide

Score 1 point for identifying each correct color.

Score 1 point for each question in number 3 answered correctly.

Score 1 point for placing crayons correctly. Score 1 point for saying correctly where the crayon is.

Very good (+)

Can name at least 4 colors, answer 3 questions, place at least 2 crayons and make at least 2 sentences correctly.

Satisfactory (✓)

Can name at least 3 colors, answer 2 questions, place at least 2 crayons and make at least 2 sentences correctly.

Needs additional support (-)

Cannot name more than 2 colors, cannot answer more than 1 question, cannot place more than 1 crayon and cannot make any sentence correctly.
