Focus on activity: used to

Target audience (age): Ensino Fundamental F2 (last grades)/ Ensino Médio/ Language Schools
 Lesson links: English ID 2, Unit 4; The Big Picture B1+, Unit 2; The Big Picture B2, Unit 2; Log in 4, Unit 3
 Aim: practice used to with different skills (speaking, listening, reading)
 Duration: 30-40 minutes
 Organization: groups
 Material: CD or MP3 with the song, CD player or computer to play the song or the video clip

Preparation: Watch the video clip/ listen to the song; have the worksheets ready

Procedure:

- Ask students to check what they used to do before 12 years old.
- Then ask them to walk around the classroom, interview their classmates asking *Did you use to* _____?
 When they find two classmates who used to do something similar to them, students can go back to their seats. It's ok if they don't find anyone with similarities.
- Play the beginning of the song or show the video and ask students to cross out the extra words.
- Play it again and check their answers.
- Divide students in pairs and ask them to think about the king's story. Have them write it down. Invite some volunteers to read their stories to the group.
- Ask volunteers to read King Midas' story and exchange opinions with the other students.

Wrap up: Work in groups and change part of the stories of the kings with *used to*. Present to the other students.
